### Notice of Primary Election R.C. 3501.03

The Board of Elections of Fairfield County, Ohio, issues this Proclamation and Notice of Election.

A **Primary Election** will be held on **Tuesday**, the 8<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2018, at the usual place of holding elections in each and every precinct throughout the County or at such places as the Board may designate, for the purpose of choosing the following offices:

State of Ohio: Governor and Lieutenant Governor, Attorney General, Auditor of State, Secretary of State, Treasurer of State, U.S. Senator, Representative Congress 15<sup>th</sup> District, Justice of the Supreme Court FTC 1/1/2019, Justice of the Supreme Court FTC 1/2/2019, Judge of the Court of Appeals 5th District FTC 2/9/2019, Judge of the Court of Appeals 5th District FTC 2/10/2019, Judge of the Court of Appeals 5th District FTC 2/11/2019, Member of State Central Committee, Man, Member of State Central Committee, Woman, State Representative 77<sup>th</sup> District, State Representative 78<sup>th</sup> District

Fairfield County: Judge of the Court of Common Pleas FTC 1/1/2019, Judge of the Court of Common Pleas Domestic Relations FTC 1/2/2019, County Commissioner, County Auditor, Member of County Central Committee

and determining the following questions or issues:

State: Issue One - Creates a bipartisan, public process for drawing congressional districts.

Schools: Amanda-Clearcreek LSD, 1.5% earned income tax, current operating expenses, 5 years, additional. Bloom-Carroll, constructing a new K-5 building, \$30,000,000.00 bond repaid annually estimated at 4.3 mills for 37 years, new and 1.2 mills, acquisition and construction of permanent improvements, continuing period of time, additional.

Municipal: City of Columbus, charter amendment city council districts. Village of Thurston, 4.4 mills, police protection, continuing period of time, additional.

Township: Berne Township, 5 mills, fire protection, continuing period of time, additional. Violet Township, 0.2 mill, senior citizens services, 5 years, renewal.

The polls for the election will open at 6:30 a.m. and remain open until 7:30 p.m. on election day.
