

**NOTICE OF ELECTION ON TAX LEVY IN EXCESS  
OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION**

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a Resolution of the Township Trustees of the Township of Clearcreek, Ohio passed on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of December 2018, there will be submitted to a vote of the people at the Primary/Special Election to be held at the regular places of voting on Tuesday, the 7<sup>th</sup> day of May 2019, the question of levying a tax, in excess of the ten mill limitation, for the benefit of the Township of Clearcreek for the purpose of providing and maintaining township roads.

Tax being a renewal tax of one half (.5) mill at a rate not exceeding one half (.5) mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to five cents (\$0.05) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five (5) years, commencing in 2019, first due in calendar year 2020.

The polls for the election will open at 6:30 a.m. and remain open until 7:30 p.m. on election day.
