

## **Notice of Election on Proposition**

R.C. 3501.11(G)

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a Resolution of the City Council of Lancaster of Fairfield County, Ohio, passed on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of July 2019, there will be submitted to a vote of the people of the City of Lancaster at the General Election to be held at the regular places of voting, on Tuesday, the 5<sup>th</sup> day of November 2019, the question of “Shall Proposed Temporary Ordinance No. 11-19\* of the Lancaster City Council providing for an increase in the City income tax by forty-five hundredths of one percent (0.45%) from the current rate of one and seventy-five hundredths percent (1.75%) to a rate of two and twenty hundredths percent (2.20%), beginning January 1, 2020, with the two and twenty hundredths tax rate apportioned as follows: (i) tax at the rate of fifteen hundredths of one percent (0.15%) used for operating, maintaining, repairing and providing capital facilities for municipal park and recreational activities and facilities, for the period January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2022, (ii) tax at the rate of forty-five hundredths of one percent (0.45%) next used for operating, maintaining, repairing and providing capital facilities for the Fire and Police Departments of the City; (iii) tax at the rate of fifteen hundredths of one percent (0.15%) next used for providing fire services within the City and acquiring equipment for such services and paying principal and interest on securities issued and public obligations incurred to finance such equipment; (iii) tax at the rate of one and forty-five hundredths percent (1.45%) finally used for general municipal operations, be passed?”

The polls for the election will open at 6:30 a.m. and remain open until 7:30 p.m. on election day.
